What a wonderful week it's been! This week has seen the start of formal learning across all classrooms. Juniors have been working on SoundsWrite (a phonics, sound development program), so parents may hear "Say the Sound, write the word", "Say the sound, read the word" from their children!

Our seniors also began their JEMM and EMM (maths mastery) sessions. These are heaps of fun, as students are led through a range of maths questions and "debug" their answers, sharing their feedback, and how they worked out the questions with others.

Our Literacy Intervention Team is completing assessments of sound, letter and word knowledge, so we can target individual students who need extra support. We thank them for their hard work, and look forward to the program getting started in the next 2 weeks.


