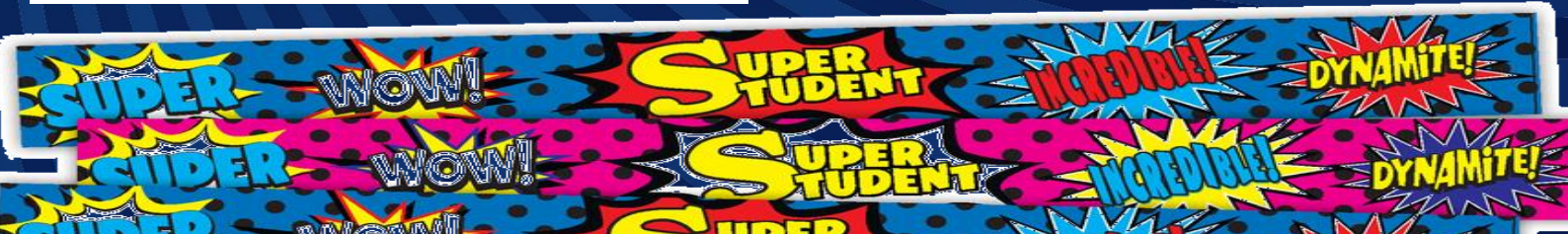


Connor Ashworth

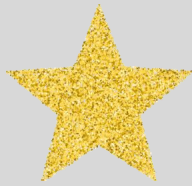

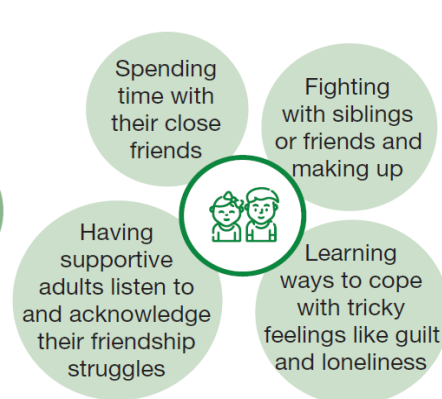
