The Afterschool Care service is open Monday through to Friday and operates daily from 3.20pm until 6.30pm. We provide a bus which collects from children from St John's, Portland Primary School, North Primary and South Portland Primary which transports them to the All saints Primary School. We also have a walking school bus from Bundarra Primary School. The bus is supervised by one of the Afterschool Care educators.




