## Ngata from Mrs Hulonce...

### Ngatanwarr!

Welcome back to Term 3, for another busy term of learning. The term has started quite positively, with students quickly settling back into routine. We appreciate everyone using the appropriate STOP, DROP & Go Zones for student arrival and collection from school. Please be mindful when using this area that it's drive through, and do not park, allowing others to collect their children. We attempt to have a staff member on duty at all times, but sometimes this is unattended. Students are well familiar with how this zone works so should be able to move through quite quickly.

We started the term with a smoking ceremony for NAIDOC WEEK. This was held in what is to become our Yarkeen Mirring (Dreaming Land) near Edgar Street. It was awesome to learn more about healing country, how we interact with country and the importance of five different components to make things grow- fire, water, flora, soil and people. We added handprints to the ground. Traditional roles were explored and appropriate dances learnt.

This also allowed Shea to introduce himself and his arts project, which started this week also. Shea is working with us as part of Regional Arts Victoria initiative to get creative workers in schools. We have developed a project plan (complimenting the Edgar Street area development), with a focus on Gunditjmara seasons and country. Exciting times!

### Other Term 3 happenings:

- **Bike/ Fitness Track construction-** an Active Kids project which will begin this term, around oval area. (Concept plans being developed now)
- **Natural Playspace development-** project thanks to Victorian Schools Building Authority. To incorporate different land areas and seasons, linking in with Shea's work.
- **SFYS Applied Learning Project-** \$8,000 School Focused Youth Service grant to run this program as part of our Kupa Ngai. Mr Grinstead will be working weekly with a group of students on woodwork.
- **Gunditjmara Culture & language-** Continuing this work with Auntie Delsie and new KESO- Kate Mee. This term will see us learn more about family, places, commands, and animals. This will involve new language cards (created with a \$2,000 Bank First grant), exciting!
- **Book Fair-** Last week in July, in LST room.

This morning has seen the implementation of updated Victorian health advice regarding mask wearing in schools (effective today). We will keep you updated if anything changes in this space- stay tuned (and safe!)
