#### Ngata from Mrs Hulonce...

With our Premier Dan Andrews' announcement yesterday we are continuing with remote and flexible learning until at least the end of term 3.

While this is disappointing news, we can all take strength from the fact that we are resilient, strong and "all over" this remote and flexible learning thing.

Our kids are still learning, just in a different way. Our families are together. We are safe from Covid and the Delta strain right now. There are plenty of positives in amongst the hard times.

School staff are delighted at how well teaching and learning is progressing. You will notice we have altered things a little and you'll be getting WebEx meeting requests. It's vital that students attend these, at the designated time, so they don't miss out on valuable teaching and learning. I've sat in on a few now, and they have simply revolutionised remote learning. Our children have a chance for some quality teaching time with their teacher- LIVE. The ability for the teacher to respond in the moment is what teaching is all about. Teaching and learning is a fluid, organic process, changing and diverting and reacting to student learning and questions in real time. It's a beautiful thing to witness. The impact of online live teaching this week has been monumental. I am immensely proud of Bundarra's staff for trusting this journey and giving it a go. We are also so proud of everyone at home for their efforts in attending WebEx meetings and learning together with us.

NAPLAN results came back this week and are remarkable. Overwhelmingly positive, at Bundarra and across the state, despite the challenges we experienced in 2020 and interruptions to traditional learning as we know it. Individual student NAPLAN results (for Grade 3 and 5 students) will be released to families when we can have you back ONSITE. If you'd like your child's results earlier, please contact the office.

## **Results in NAPLAN 2021**

The incredible resilience and hard work of Victorian educators, students and families has been reflected in the remarkable results for this year's NAPLAN tests.

#### Leading the nation

Victoria has held top spot as the highest-performing jurisdiction on seven out of ten measures in the primary school years. Our Year 3 and Year 5 numeracy results were the highest in the country.

Year 7 students achieved the highest scores of any jurisdiction for the foundation skills of Reading and Numeracy, and our Year 9 students achieved the highest scores for Spelling.


#### More students achieving their best


Victoria also improved on our 2019 results. Reading was a particular highlight, with students in years 3, 5 and 7 demonstrating significant improvement.

More than 62 per cent of Year 3 students are now achieving in the top two bands for Reading, representing an increase of almost ten per cent from 2015.

Since 2015, the number of students in the bottom two bands for Reading has decreased by more than eight percentage points for Year 5 students and more than two percentage points for Year 3 students.

In years 3 and 5, over 13,000 more students are achieving at the highest reading levels compared to 2015.
